

Message from the President

m Welcome to the first newsletter of the Melbourne Clivia Group.

For those of us who love clivia, September and October have to be the best months. All our work through the year is rewarded, we hope, by beautiful blooms, and the excitement—and sometimes disappointment—of first flowers comes mostly at this time of the year.

We are lucky to have in our group, several individuals who have been growing clivia for 30 years or more as well as those who possess just one plant (at the moment). In between are the rest of us with little or more experience in growing clivias. What this means is that we can all learn from each other. There are many different techniques that people employ to grow and care for their clivia and our group will provide the forum for us to share these things among ourselves.

The committee met on Saturday 6th September to undertake some planning, for 2008 in the main, and we feel sure that the September and October meetings will contain topics of interest for everyone.

In order to run as a club organisation, the committee recommends that an individual membership be \$15, with each additional member of a family an extra \$10 each. The current fee will run until the end of 2009, with membership coinciding with the calendar year. The newsletter will be distributed to the first individual in each family group. We plan to continue offering a raffle at our coming meetings but wish to point out that this is entirely OPTIONAL but the proceeds will help with some of the ongoing costs, such as venue hire and insurance, along with the membership fees.

Although the newly-elected committee will do its best to coordinate the group, we do look forward to maximum participation from every member. We have provided our contact phone numbers and email addresses so that we can be contacted and we will do our best to assist. We really want everyone to derive what they want from the group and we will always be available for feedback and would welcome suggestions.

Finally, we look forward to seeing more pots of flowering clivia brought to the meetings over the next two months.
